Diversified Plastics Exceeds Goal for Community Food Drive

(Minneapolis, MN – April 2, 2009) Food and cash donations totaling 677 pounds were collected by Diversified Plastics, Inc. during their annual *Bonnie Schultz Memorial Food Drive*. This year's target goal of 500 pounds was exceeded when company employees donated 525 pounds. The North Hennepin County Chamber of Commerce membership raised the total amount by donating an additional 152 pounds of food and cash.
